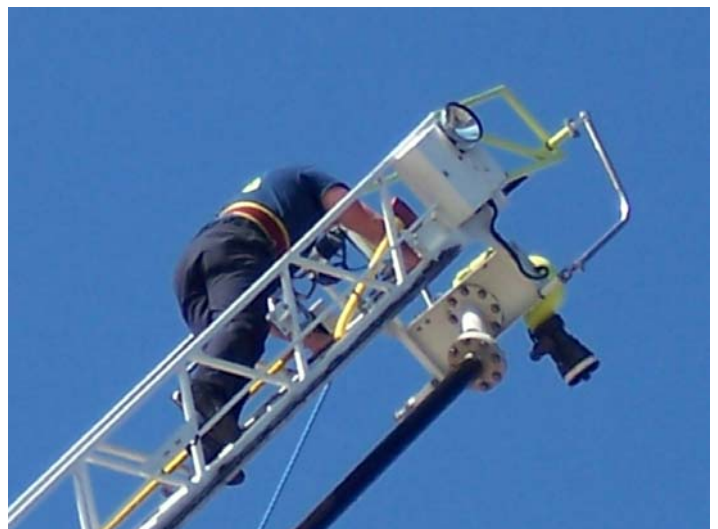
Other events will be posted throughout the summer, so please check the bulletin boards periodically if you have any interest in working the Safety Trailer.
