Burning may only be conducted between the hours of 8 AM & 5 PM Mon-Friday. Heavy oils, asphaltic materials, items containing natural or synthetic rubber, or any materials other than plant growth, which produce unreasonable amounts of smoke may not be burned; nor may these substances be used to start a fire. Burning must be controlled so that a traffic hazard is not created. Area around the burn site must be cleared of combustibles. Constant attendance is required. There must be a means to extinguish the fire at the burn site. This permit may be revoked for health and/or safety reasons or if burning becomes a public nuisance. Burn Permit application must be submitted to the St. George Fire Department administration office at least two business days in advance of planned burning. I have read the above conditions and understand that this permit does not exempt or excuse the person responsible from consequences of or the damages or injuries resulting from the burning.
